

Roads Division

This division employs ten operators and one foreman in the maintenance of drainage ditches and other drainage facilities around town, roadside mowing, erection and removal of snow-fence, snow plowing, salting, and anti-icing and patching of roads, and other general maintenance of the roadways. The division presently maintains approximately 135 miles of roadway.

Please first identify if the road is maintained by Montgomery Township or the State of New Jersey or Somerset County or even possibly by your neighborhood's management company. Route 206 is a New Jersey State Highway maintained by the NJ Dept. of Transportation.

Somerset County Roads

Any main roads in Montgomery, excluding Rt. 206, associated with a route number are maintained by Somerset County. These include Dutchtown-Harlingen Rd. (Rt. 604), Belle Mead-Blawenburg Rd aka The Great Rd. (Rt. 601), Georgetown-Franklin Turnpike (Rt. 518), River Rd. (Rt. 533), and Kingston-River Rd. (Rt. 605).
